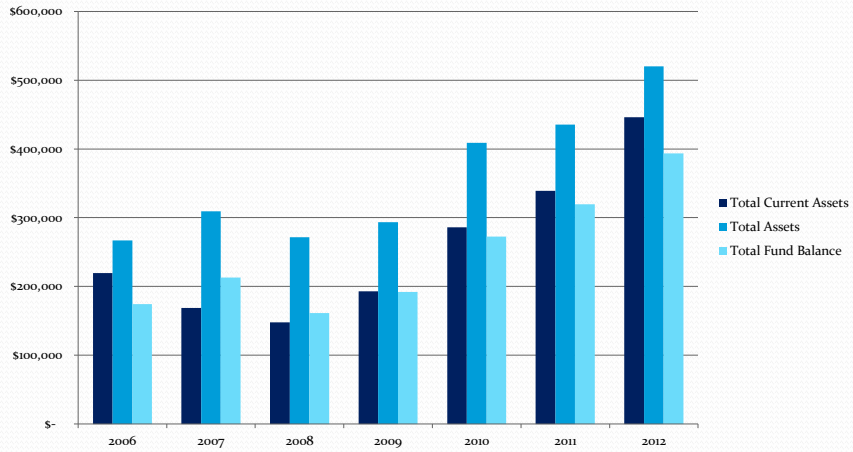
Increased Membership Dues and League Fees

- In order to meet our budgetary goals, it is necessary to increase the Membership Dues and League Fees
 - Should have done this last year, but we deferred the increases
- General Membership will increase to \$260
 - Novice - \$220, Junior U21 - \$130, Junior U16 - \$65, Social - \$65
- League Fee will increase to \$150 per league
- Open House Fees increase from \$15 to \$20 per person

Capital Improvement Projects

- Need Membership Approval for Major Capital Projects
 - Cooling Tower will require \$20,000 - \$22,000
 - Depends on installation costs
 - Upgrade on-ice video (\$5000 - \$8000)
 - Better cameras to capture the whole sheet, maybe even both ends of the ice
 - Better monitors
 - Internet Broadcast capabilities
- Need a motion from the floor to approve spending these amounts in FY2012/2013.

Article Five. Board of Trustees

Section 5.01 Number, Terms, Powers and Voting Rights of Trustees:

The business, property and affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees composed of ~~eleven~~ **nine (9)** persons who shall be General Members of the Corporation. Except for the immediate Past President, the Trustees shall be elected for a term of two (2) years and the number of Trustees elected each year shall be that which is required to fill the vacated positions. ~~Normally this would mean five (5) Trustees to be elected each year.~~ The immediate Past President shall serve a one (1) year term as a Trustee. The Board of Trustees shall make such rules and policies as they deem necessary. Each Trustee shall have one vote at all meetings of the Board of Trustees.

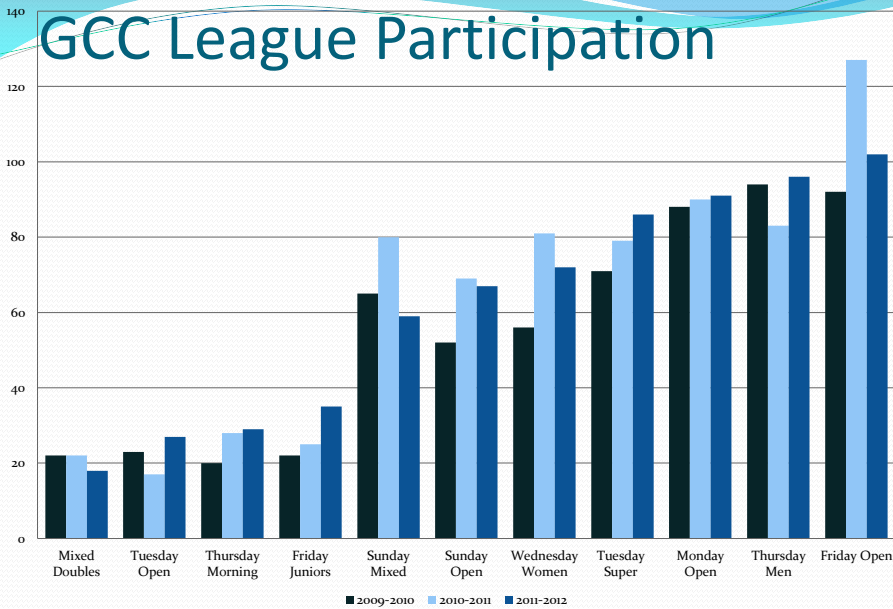
