Increased Dues

- USCA plans to increase member dues this year by \$1
 - On Average we pay \$27/member to USCA
 - USWCA get \$5 (women only)
- We're expecting the WSCA to raise dues
 - Currently \$7/member, unchanged for 10 years.

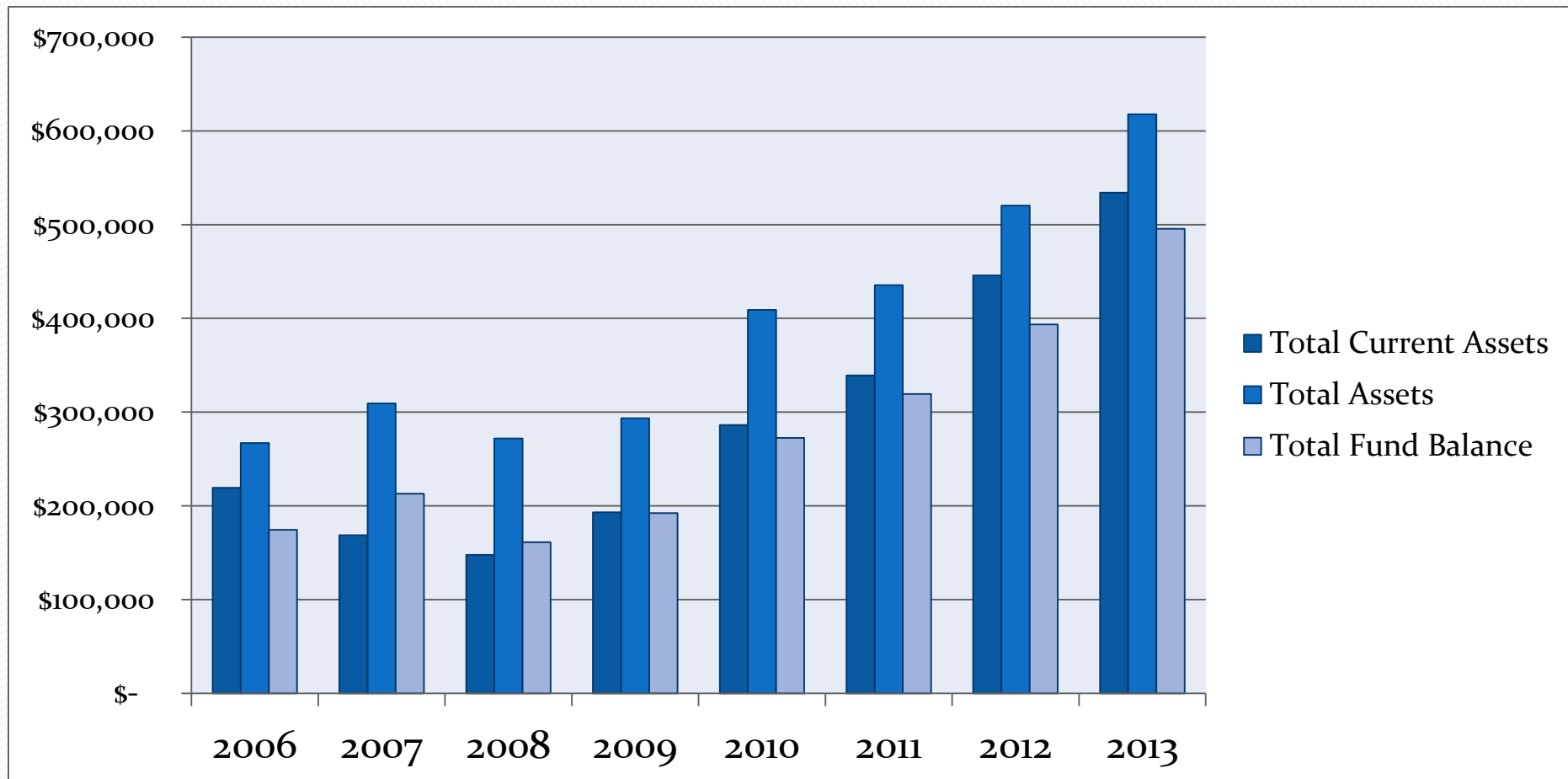
Increased League Fees

- In order to meet our budgetary goals, it is necessary to increase the League Fees by \$5
 - This is to avoid the need to do a larger increase all at once
- League Fee will increase to \$155 per league.
- Plan moving forward is to keep the club open into June every year (more guaranteed outreach income).

Capital Improvement Projects

- Upgrade on-ice video (\$10000 - \$15000)
 - Better cameras to capture the whole sheet, maybe even both ends of the ice
 - Better monitors
 - Internet Broadcast capabilities
- New Beer Fridge!
 - Beer must be cold
 - Maybe even more beer! Because Presidents drink free!

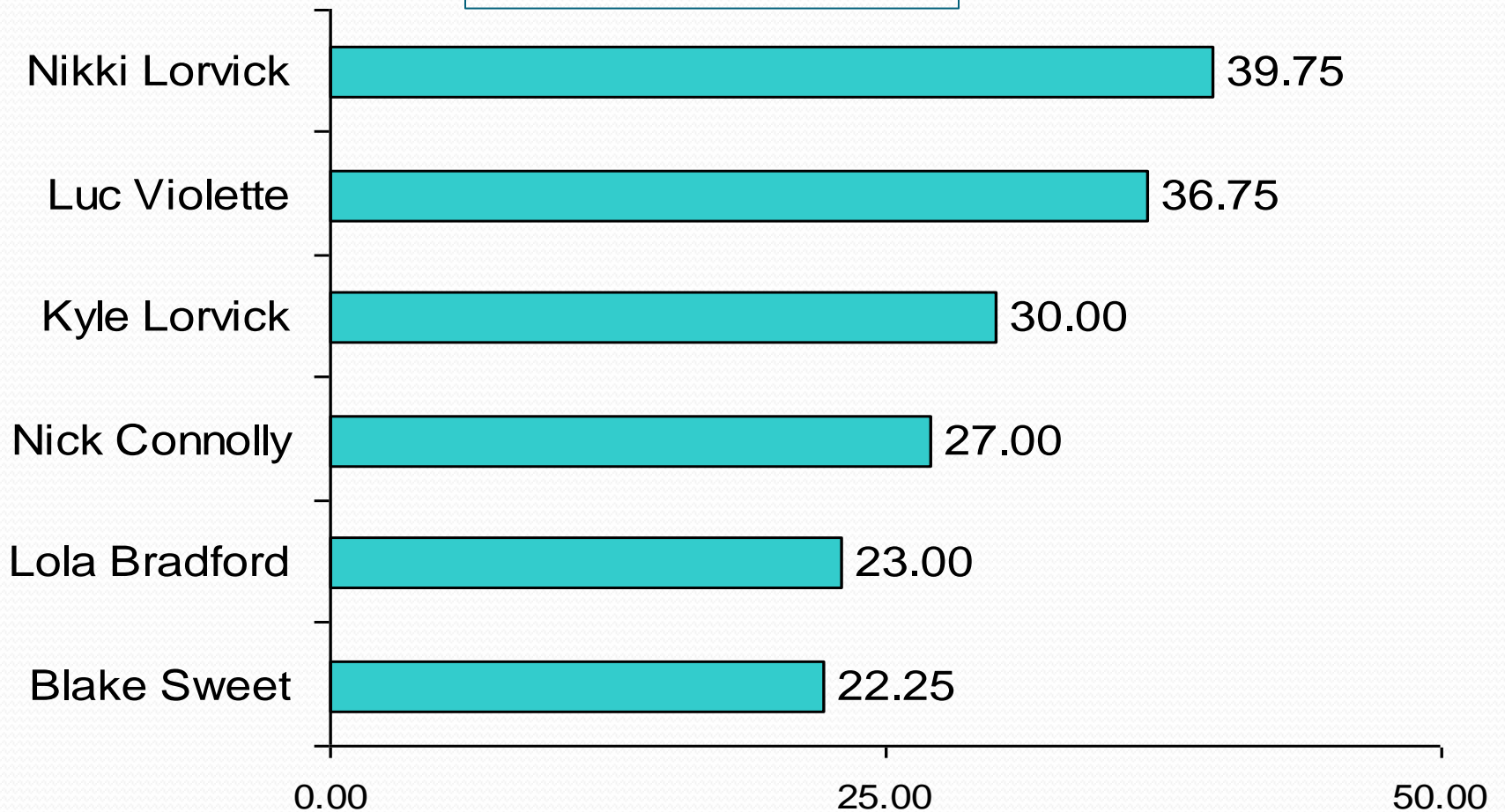


Total Volunteer Hours = 328
