Introduction

The Granite Curling Club is striving to make this season as normal as possible with no planned modifications to gameplay or leagues. To make it through this season safely, without the need for additional restrictions, we need everyone to be responsible and adhere to these guidelines. If risk levels become higher locally or we have evidence that these precautions are not sufficient, the Board will take whatever steps necessary to allow the club to operate safely.

Vaccination

All members and guests over age 12 must be vaccinated (except in cases of religious or medical exceptions) and attest to their vaccination status.

General

- If you are sick, stay home and get tested.
- If you are uncomfortable with handshakes, you can bump fists, "chicken wing", tip your cap, or wave from afar.
- Hand sanitizer will be provided at several locations around the building.

Contact Tracing

Any member or guest testing positive should notify the club immediately by emailing covid@curlingseattle.org so we can notify other members of the dates and times when you were at the club recently. Names will not be released unless explicitly permitted by the person testing positive.

- Notices about any positive case will be sent to all current members of the club.
- Guests who were at the club on impacted dates will be notified as well. Notification will be sent to the contact information indicated on the sign-in sheet (see below).

Positive Cases

Any member testing positive for COVID-19 must follow CDC guidance and isolate for 10 days (guidance as of 7/11) before returning to the club. <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/if-you-are-sick/isolation.html>

Leagues

- Junior League
 - All people present need to wear a mask, regardless of vaccination status, to help protect the unvaccinated kids.
 - Masks required upstairs on Friday while Juniors are in the building (until 7:00p)
- Other leagues
 - No modifications

Guests/Non-Members

- All non-members, including guests of members, must sign-in upon arrival upon arrival, attest to vaccination status, and provide contact info for contact tracing. There are no exceptions.
- The member bringing guests to the club is responsible for ensuring that this happens and that all other rules are followed.

Vaccination Exempt, Non-Vaccinated Members (religious, medical, & Juniors under the age of 12 years)

- Any non-vaccinated member with a known exposure to COVID-19 must follow CDC guidance and quarantine for 14 days (guidance as of 7/11) after the date of exposure.

- We're adopting the same guidelines followed by airlines as of July 2021:
 - Masks must be worn at all times within the club.
 - Masks may be removed briefly to bite or sip, but must stay on at all other times.
 - Masks must be purpose-built masks without vent OR doubled gaiter and must cover nose and mouth completely.
- A list of members who must follow these guidelines will be provided to Board Members and League Managers.

Rentals

- No modifications (except following vaccine/mask guidelines).
- Additional protocols unique to a specific rental could be created that will either meet or exceed our minimum guidelines. In no instance will GCC's overall protocols be loosened to accommodate a rental.

Bonspiels

Protocols will be announced per-event at time of registration open. This could be a reiteration of GCC's overall policies or additional protocols that are unique to the bonspiel. In no instance will GCC's overall protocols be loosened to accommodate a bonspiel.
