

Timing Equipment at Granite Curling Club

Granite CC has computers and monitors available for timing in the boardroom. Timing ensures both teams receive equal thinking time and helps maintain a consistent pace of play. Games at the playdown and national level are timed, and equipment is available to members for scrimmage games to help prepare for competitive play.

The timing program used by curlers worldwide is called [CurlTime](https://worldcurling.org/timing/). All GCC timing computers have this program pre-installed. If you've never used it before, we recommend visiting <https://worldcurling.org/timing/> to learn more about how to time a game. If you have more questions, email development@curlingseattle.org.

Where equipment is located:

Lower white cabinets on the north wall of the GCC Boardroom. All the computers and associated cables are stored in a singular black pelican case on the bottom shelf of the left lower cabinet. The monitors are stored individually in the lower right cabinet.

Necessary Equipment

When timing a game, we recommend setting up the computer and monitor on the downstairs tables in the warm room with the monitor facing the ice. Timers should have a full view of both t-lines and teams should have a full view of the monitor.

There is no official checkout procedure for this equipment; however, we ask that after using the timing equipment, cords and computers must be returned to the pelican case. Monitors should also be carefully returned to the cabinet.
